In an 8.5m x 1.5m boat, the team rowed 2 hours on, 2 hours off 24/7. Battling big weather, fatigue and seasickness and preparing for this challenge during a global pandemic, Ocean Sheroes Purusha Gordon will share stories, reflections and learnings from their time at sea. Purusha, Mum of two, aged 43 believes any challenge in life starts with 'Being Brave and Saying Yes' and how breaking through the fear and having a positive mindset can lead to a remarkable change in life.
